**DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application for a Managers Certificate by Alec Bruce MacPherson. The application is supported with a copy of the required Licensed Controller Qualification (LCQ) and the Licensed Controller Qualification Bridging Test.

Section 222 of the Act provides that in considering an application for a managers certificate the Licensing Committee must have regard for the following matters :

- (a) the applicant's suitability to be a manager:
- (b) any convictions recorded against the applicant:
- (c) any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:
- (d) any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under section 218:
- (e) any matters dealt with in any report made under section 220.

The committee has received reports on the application from the Police and the Licensing Inspector and none have raised matters in opposition. Accordingly we deal with the matters on the papers.

The applicant is currently the liquor manager and grocery supervisor for New World Onerahi. Previously, he worked as a shop assistant for Hikurangi Four Square for 3 years, and part of his job was selling alcohol under a certificated manager.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.222 of the Act and the application is granted. The certificate may issue immediately.
