**DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)**

This is an application for a Managers Certificate by Alice Aroha Laurence. The application is supported with a copy of the required Licensed Controller Qualification (LCQ) and the Licensed Controller Qualification Bridging Test.

Section 222 of the Act provides that in considering an application for a managers certificate the Licensing Committee must have regard for the following matters :

- (a) the applicant's suitability to be a manager:
- (b) any convictions recorded against the applicant:
- (c) any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:
- (d) any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under section 218:
- (e) any matters dealt with in any report made under section 220.

The committee has received reports on the application from the Police and the Licensing Inspector and none have raised matters in opposition. Accordingly we deal with the matters on the papers.

The applicant has been working as a bar person for the Kamo Rugby and Squash Club since 2010. She was granted a managers certificate under the Sale of Liquor Act 1989 by the Whangarei District Licensing Agency in September 2012 which was allowed to lapse.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.222 of the Act and the application is granted. The certificate may issue immediately.
