DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application for a Manager's Certificate by **Karen Marie Ayton**. The application is supported with a copy of the required Licensed Controller Qualification.

Section 222 of the Act provides that in considering an application for a manager's certificate the Licensing Committee must have regard for the following matters:

- (a) the applicant's suitability to be a manager:
- (b) any convictions recorded against the applicant:
- (c) any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:
- (d) any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under section 218:
- (e) any matters dealt with in any report made under section 220.

The committee has received reports on the application from the Police and the Licensing Inspector and neither has raised matters in opposition. Accordingly the committee deals with the matters on the papers.

The applicant has been the check out supervisor for Regent New World for 5 months now, and monitoring the alcohol sales at the check out is part of her job. She also worked as a check out supervisor for Regent New World between April 2003 and June 2006.

The committee is satisfied as to the matters to which it must have regard as set out in s.222 of the Act and the application is granted. The certificate may issue immediately expiring at the close of the day twelve months after the day of issue.
