DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application for a Managers Certificate by Stanley Ho-Yen Cheung. The application is supported with a copy of the required Licensed Controller Qualification (LCQ) and the Licensed Controller Qualification Bridging Test.

Section 222 of the Act provides that in considering an application for a managers certificate the Licensing Committee must have regard for the following matters :

- (a) the applicant's suitability to be a manager:
- (b) any convictions recorded against the applicant:
- (c) any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:
- (d) any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under section 218:
- (e) any matters dealt with in any report made under section 220.

The applicant has been working for Countdown Whangarei, located on Okara Drive, Whangarei for 13 months. He has worked under a licensed duty manager since August 2013. Prior to this, he worked as a cinema sales attendant and then a projectionist at Event Cinemas in Whangarei since 2002.

The committee has received reports on the application from the Police and the Licensing Inspector and none have raised matters in opposition. Accordingly we deal with the matters on the papers. We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.222 of the Act and the application is granted. The certificate may issue immediately.
