DECISION (ON THE PAPERS)

This is an application for a Manager's Certificate by **Kylie Lin Martin**. The application is supported with a copy of the required Licensed Controller Qualification and the Licensed Controller Qualification Bridging Test.

Section 222 of the Act provides that in considering an application for a manager's certificate the Licensing Committee must have regard for the following matters:

- (a) the applicant's suitability to be a manager:
- (b) any convictions recorded against the applicant:
- (c) any experience, in particular recent experience, that the applicant has had in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force:
- (d) any relevant training, in particular recent training, that the applicant has undertaken and evidence that the applicant holds the prescribed qualification required under section 218:
- (e) any matters dealt with in any report made under section 220.

The committee has received reports on the application from the Police and the Licensing Inspector and neither has raised matters in opposition. Accordingly the committee deals with the matters on the papers.

The applicant has more than ten years' experience working on licensed premises between 1999-2009, including The Whangaparaoa Hotel and The Crows Nest Bar, both in Auckland. During those periods, she held a manager's certificate issued by the Rodney District Council, which lapsed when she changed career.

Currently, the applicant is a hospitality tutor for People Potential, Whangarei campus. Teaching the Licence Controller Qualification will form part of her job. In addition, People Potential provides bar services to clients and organisations, in which the applicant will be required to act as a duty manager.

The committee is satisfied as to the matters to which it must have regard as set out in s.222 of the Act and the application is granted. The certificate may issue immediately.
