Prize terms and conditions

- A. To be eligible for the prize draw you must be over 18 years old, live in the Whangarei District and have completed the survey via the Whangarei District Council website.

- B. To enter the prize draw you must provide your contact details at the end of the Whangarei District Council survey
- C. All entries for the prize draw must be **completed before 3pm on Friday 9 February 2018**.
- D. The winners of the prize draw will win one double pass to the 2018 Whangarei Fritter Festival. The retail value is \$110. There are 5 double passes to be won.
- E. Only one entry per person is permitted.
- F. Only the person who originally entered the prize draw can be awarded the prize.
- G. The prize draw is not open to Whangarei District Council employees or members of their immediate families.
- H. The winners will be randomly drawn at 11am on Monday, 12 February 2018 at Whangarei District Council offices at Forum North, 7 Rust Ave, Whangarei.
