- a) All the reasons set out in the SHANZ primary submission PC131-153;
- b) There is clear jurisdiction under the Resource Management Act, 1991 (the Act) for territorial authorities to include provisions in regional and district plans to address GMOs.
- c) The inclusion of objectives, policies and rules in district plans is necessary for territorial authorities to carry out their functions under s31 of the Act.
- d) There is significant risk that if GMOs are not managed under district plans:
 - The sustainable management of actual and potential district wide resources for and areas of organic farming and horticulture will not be appropriately planned for or protected;
 - Significant economic damage to existing organic farming enterprises could occur to the point they become unsustainable;
 - The integrity and heritage value of outstanding areas of natural resources and ecosystems would be adversely impacted;
 - Tangata Whenua values will not be appropriately provided for; and
 - The ability of people and communities to provide for their wellbeing and envisaged by s5 of the Act will be reduced.
- e) PC131 is the most appropriate means to achieve the purpose of the Act.

I oppose these submissions because in my view allowing GE in New Zealand at this time is the wrong path to take. We are an agricultural nation and many countries are wanting GE free products. By staying GE Free we have an export advantage to those countries. At the moment the drive to bring GE to New Zealand is principally coming from multinational corporate companies who are driven by economics, principally for their own company bottom lines and not for the overall benefit of the countries to whom they bring their technology. The technology is failing overall to bring promised increased crop yields and many questions are correctly being raised about the effects on human health by consuming GE food either directly or indirectly by consumption of eg animals that have been feed on say GE corn. The GE technology has not been independently proven to be safe to humans and we need to move on the edge of caution rather than just allow GE to take place in our country. We are an agricultural country surrounded by water and can easily be used as an isolated testing ground. We should not become a testing ground, nor an economic cash cow for overseas corporates. I also understand that this technology once released cannot easily be changed in the way that it effects our soils. An analogy that I like to use is - if you paint your house red and you don't like the colour then you can paint it blue. If you cover your landscape with GE and you later don't like it then you cannot change it. We don't have to buy the salesman's products – we have a right to say NO – and I believe that at this time we must continue to say NO.
