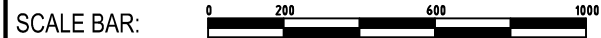


WHANGAREI DISTRICT COUNCIL SPEED LIMITS BYLAW



1. SCALES SHOWN ON THIS MAP ARE APPROXIMATE.
2. DIMENSIONS SHOW THE BOUNDARIES OF A SPEED LIMIT FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE BYLAW.
3. SPEED LIMIT BOUNDARIES THAT CROSS A ROAD DO SO AT RIGHT ANGLES FROM ONE SIDE TO THE OPPOSITE SIDE OF THE ROAD BY THE SHORTEST DISTANCE.
4. A SPEED LIMIT BOUNDARY MARKED ALONG A ROAD IS DEEMED TO RUN ALONG THE CARRIAGEWAY EDGE OF THAT ROAD UNLESS DIMENSIONED OR SHOWN OTHERWISE.
5. WHERE NO DIMENSION OR DISTANCE IS GIVEN OR SHOWN WHEN THE SPEED LIMIT CROSSES A ROAD AT A SIDE ROAD, THE SPEED LIMIT IS DEEMED TO CROSS THE ROAD AT THE EXTRAPOLATION OF THE SIDE ROAD CARRIAGEWAY EDGE.
6. WHERE THE BOUNDARY BETWEEN THE WHANGAREI DISTRICT AND KAIPARA DISTRICT AND FAR NORTH DISTRICT RUNS ALONG A ROAD, THIS PLAN AND BYLAW APPLY TO THE WHOLE WIDTH OF THE ROAD.
7. WHERE A ROAD CROSSES UNDER OR OVER A STATE HIGHWAY OR EXPRESSWAY, THE SPEED LIMIT ON THAT ROAD AT THAT LOCATION IS DEEMED TO BE THE SAME AS FOR THE ADJOINING SECTIONS OF EITHER SIDE OF THE STATE HIGHWAY OR EXPRESSWAY UNLESS DIMENSIONED OR SHOWN OTHERWISE.
8. ALL WHANGAREI DISTRICT COUNCIL ROADS SHOWN ON THIS MAP OUTSIDE THE URBAN TRAFFIC AREAS HAVE A SPEED LIMIT OF 100 km/h, UNLESS MARKED WITH A DIFFERENT SPEED LIMIT.
9. SPEED LIMITS ON STATE HIGHWAYS ARE NOT PART OF THIS BYLAW. THEY ARE SHOWN ON THIS MAP FOR INFORMATION ONLY. REFER TO TRANSIT NEW ZEALAND SPEED LIMIT BYLAWS FOR SPEED LIMITS ON STATE HIGHWAYS.
10. THIS MAP IS PART OF THE WHANGAREI DISTRICT COUNCIL SPEED LIMIT BYLAW 2005.
11. REFER TO SCHEDULES:
WDC S4/1 TO S4/29; WDC S5/1; WDC S6/1 TO S6/12; WDC S7/1 TO S7/8; WDC S8/1; AND WDC S12/1 TO S12/7.

LEGEND

- ROADS THAT HAVE A VARIABLE SPEED LIMIT OF 40 km/h, ROADS WITHIN A SCHOOL ZONE WHICH DECREASE TO 40 km/h DURING THE SCHOOL DAY.
- BOUNDARY OF THE URBAN TRAFFIC AREAS THAT HAVE A SPEED LIMIT OF 50 km/h, EXCEPT FOR ROADS OR AREAS MARKED WITH A DIFFERENT SPEED LIMIT.
- ROADS THAT HAVE A SPEED LIMIT OF X km/h DURING WINTER AND Y km/h DURING THE SUMMER HOLIDAY PERIOD. SUMMER HOLIDAY PERIOD STARTS THE FRIDAY BEFORE LABOUR WEEKEND AND ENDS FRIDAY AFTER EASTER WEEKEND.
- ROADS THAT HAVE A SPEED LIMIT OF 60 km/h.
- ROADS THAT HAVE A SPEED LIMIT OF 70 km/h.
- ROADS THAT HAVE A SPEED LIMIT OF 80 km/h.
- ROADS THAT HAVE A SPEED LIMIT OF 100 km/h.
- STATE HIGHWAYS, REFER TO THE TRANSIT NEW ZEALAND SPEED LIMIT BYLAWS FOR SPEED LIMITS.
- PRIVATE (PVT) ROAD.
- DISTRICT BOUNDARY WHERE IT ABUTS TO AN ADJACENT TERRITORIAL LOCAL AUTHORITY.
- DISTANCE IN METRES FROM THE CENTRELINE OF AN INTERSECTING ROAD OR A GEOGRAPHICAL FEATURE SHOWN ON THE MAP TO THE SPEED LIMIT BOUNDARY.
