1 Town Basin Carpark - Parking Charges

Date of meeting: 11 July 2017

1 Purpose

To recommend the introduction of Parking Charges for the Town Basin and Environs Carpark.

Recommendations

That Council approves;

- a) the installation of Parking Charges in the Town Basin and Environs Carpark.
- b) the carpark shall be a metered zone as set out in Plan No. 4020 attached to the report.
- c) the fee payable shall be at the rate of \$2.00 per hour or part thereof.
- d) the maximum parking time shall be 180 minutes.
- e) parking of vehicles for a greater period than 60 minutes shall be prohibited at all times on the northern side of Reyburn House Lane, from the western boundary of Lot 1 DP 109637, for a distance of 62m.

2 Background

In September 2011 Council adopted the Parking Management Strategy. The strategy set out that Council would seek to manage the parking and occupancy rates through fees. If the occupancy rates of a parking area were greater than 90% Council would increase the fees to reduce the occupancy rates to achieve between 70 and 80% occupancy, ensuring a car park would be available when required by the customers.

3 Discussion

During the recent parking strategy review it was reported that the occupancy rates for the Town Basin carpark were consistently over 90% over the day, during the week of the survey period. A recommendation from the workshop was the introduction of parking charges at the Town basin to manage the availability of parking.

It is therefore intended to introduce Pay and Display metered parking in the Town Basin and Environs Carpark as set out in the attached plan, set charges at \$2.00 per hour, and set a

maximum parking time of 180 minutes for this carpark. This should deter all day parkers and ensure parking availability and parking turnover for the Town Basin Facilities.


21 carparks on the northern side of Reyburn House Lane serve the popular children's playground, and it is intended that these carparks be free but restricted to 60 minutes' maximum parking time to serve this facility.
