**NOTICE OF SOUTHPARK CORPORATION LIMITED'S WISH TO BE A PARTY TO PROCEEDINGS**

Southpark Corporation Limited ("**Southpark**") gives notice of its wish to be a party to the appeal ENV-2020-AKL-000105 by C and K Pyle against parts of the decision of Whangarei District Council on proposed Plan Change 88 to the Whangarei District Plan.

1. Southpark made further submission X359 regarding the subject matter of these proceedings.
2. Southpark is a person who has an interest in the proceedings that is greater than the interest of the general public because it manages a large area of land within the wider Marsden Point area and wishes to ensure that an integrated approach is taken to development of the Marsden Point area, including the provision of infrastructure.
3. Southpark is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991. In any event, Southpark is directly affected by an effect of the subject matter of the appeal that:
  - 3.1 Adversely affects the environment; and
  - 3.2 Does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.
4. Southpark is interested in all aspects of the proceedings.
5. Southpark is concerned to ensure that:
  - 5.1 The relief sought is supported by appropriate technical assessments;
  - 5.2 The provision of infrastructure (including roading and sewerage) for the proposed activities is coordinated and integrated with existing and proposed services in the balance of Marsden Point; and

- 5.3 Appropriate and equitable provision is made for the proposed activities to contribute to the cost of infrastructure in Marsden Point.
6. Southpark agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
